“ Vincent showed his extraordinary generosity and hospitality by hosting our monthly Renew group meetings.

This all started in 1994 when Sacred Heart Parish participated in the Renew Program, which encouraged small groups of parishioners to gather for shared prayer, Bible study, and the discussion of religion topics that were of interest to us. The program called for these gatherings to take place at a parishioner's home. The program was slated to last less than a year, but if a Renew discussion group wanted to continue in the program, they had the option of doing that as a “small Christian community.”

As it turned out, our group met every month (almost) from September to June every year from 1994 to 2013. That's nine or ten meetings a year – for 19 years! And the most remarkable thing about it was that, except for a handful of times, Vincent hosted every one of those meetings at his home!

Sometimes we met in his living room, sometimes we met in his screened-in porch. Sometimes we had large groups of six or more, sometimes small groups of five or less. Whatever the circumstances (or the weather), Vincent was the constant, making everyone feel welcome with his quiet warmth and treating us to cookies and coffee in the kitchen after every meeting.

My wife and I were the two youngest parishioners in the group. Many of the members were already retired seniors when the group started and have since passed away. Vincent will have many friends ready to greet him in Heaven.
